Article 01 Election of Officers

To Elect the New London-Springfield Water System Precinct Officers: one Commissioner to serve a one-year term; one Commissioner to serve a three-year term; one Treasurer to serve a one-year term; one Clerk to serve a one year term; and one Moderator to serve a one year term.

Article 02 Operating Budget for the New London-Springfield Water System Precinct

To see if the New London-Springfield Water System Precinct will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Million, Three Hundred Twelve Thousand, Three Hundred Nine Dollars (\$1,312,309) for general municipal operations. This article does not include appropriations contained in special or individual articles addressed separately. The Commissioners recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required)

Article 03 Funding for Emergency System Repair

To see if the New London-Springfield Water System Precinct will vote to raise and appropriate the sum Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) for the purpose of funding Emergency System Repairs. This sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) will be taken from the unassigned fund balance and not raised by taxes. This special warrant article will be a non-lapsing appropriation per RSA 32:7, VI and will not lapse until the improvements are completed or by 12/31/2029, whichever is sooner. The Commissioners recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required).

Article 04 Funding for Building Maintenance, Repair and Upkeep

To see if the New London-Springfield Water System Precinct will vote to appropriate the sum of Forty-seven Thousand Two Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$47,225) for the purpose of Building Maintenance, Repairs and Upkeep. The sum of Forty-seven Thousand Two Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$47,225) to be taken from the unassigned fund and not raised by taxes. Article 05 Funding for Lead Service Line Inventory

To see if the New London-Springfield Water System Precinct will vote to appropriate the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) for the purpose of identifying unknown service lines as required by NHDES.. The sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) was awarded to the New London Springfield Water System Precinct by NHDES in the form of a 100% Lead Service Line Inventory Grant and will not raised by taxes. This special warrant article will be a non-lapsing appropriation per RSA 32:7, VI and will not lapse until the work is completed or by 12/31/2027, whichever is sooner. The Commissioners recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required)
